DRESS CODE

The Governing Council and staff at Challa Gardens Primary School believe that the wearing of the School Uniform Dress Code:

- * contributes to whole school unity and pride
- * develops self esteem through the feeling of 'belonging'
- * relieves parents and students of pressure to purchase high cost brand name clothing
- * develops a positive image of Challa Gardens PS in the wider community
- * ensures that students are safe, comfortable and adequately protected from UV rays
- * assists identification of students during excursions
- * maintains sufficient choice for students

All students attending Challa Gardens PS are strongly encouraged to wear School Uniform at school. School uniform is Navy and Gold with the logo of the tree and children. Students may choose from the following:

Windcheaters	Windcheater - Navy or Gold with embroidered logo - Plain navy or gold
Tops (Polo shirts – long or short sleeved)	Navy with gold trim or Gold with navy trim with printed logo Plain navy or gold
Shorts or bike pants	Navy
Pants (Trouser or track pants)	Navy
Skirts	Navy
Dresses	Navy and white check
Jackets	Navy
Hats	Sun safe only
Jewellery	Other than small sleepers and studs - not encouraged for safety reasons. No face jewellery.

Footwear Must meet safety standards. THONGS/ SCUFFS and PLATFORMS are not acceptable. Sandals must be of supportive design and protect toes from scuffing. Lace ups and sneakers are recommended for winter months.

Ideally clothing should have the school logo. Large brand names, prints, offensive words or pictures are not acceptable.

Tank tops, midriff tops, sleeveless or backless clothing is not acceptable, as they do not provide sufficient protection from the sun. Hats must be worn all year round for all outside activities. Children who do not have hats on will spend playtime under the donut shelter. Hats are not to be worn indoors.

In cold weather avoid dressing children in clothing, which cannot be readily removed in warm classrooms or during vigorous activity (e.g. Layers). Please encourage and assist your children in learning how to manage his/her clothing e.g. buttons, buckles and laces.

School uniforms/dress code are to be worn to all excursions/outings and sporting events.
